Do I have to initiate an investigation to receive supportive measures?

No. We provide supportive measures for anyone who has experienced sexual misconduct. They include, but are not limited to counseling services, academic support, relocation, escort services, request for additional time on completing assignments, etc.

If I report an incident to OEO, will you automatically start an investigation or contact the other Party?

No. We always meet with the impacted party first to listen to their concerns and wishes. In most instances, we respect a person's wishes – to move forward or not to move forward. There are only extreme situations when we may have to move forward because there is a major danger involved but even in these instances, we talk with the impacted party first.
